

ORDINANCE NO. 308

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF CLYMER, COUNTY OF INDIANA AND COMMONWEALTH OF PENNSYLVANIA, AMENDING ORDINANCES NOS. 298 AND 293 TO INCREASE THE REAL ESTATE TAX FROM 21 MILLS TO 22 MILLS AND TO DECREASE THE STREET LIGHT TAX FROM 5 MILLS TO 4 MILLS FOR THE YEAR 2003 AND THEREAFTER

BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED by the Borough Council of the Borough of Clymer, Indiana County, Pennsylvania, and it is hereby ordained and enacted as follows:

That Paragraph 3 of Ordinance No. 293 be amended as follows:

3. The street light tax levied on real estate within the Borough of Clymer shall be reduced from 5 mills to 4 mills on real estate subject to taxation for Borough purposes for the Year 2003 and thereafter.

That Paragraph 2 of Ordinance No. 293 and Ordinance No. 298 be amended as follows:

2. The real estate tax levied on real estate within the Borough of Clymer shall be increased from 21 mills to 22 mills on real estate subject to taxation for Borough purposes for the year 2003 and thereafter.

Except as amended herein, each and every other provision of Ordinance No. 293 and Ordinance No. 298 shall remain in full force and effect.
