OF BOROUGH OF CLYMER
INDIANA COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF CLYMER
ADOPTING THE UNIFORM CONSTRUCTION CODE OF PENNSYLVANIA AS THE OFFICIAL
BUILDING CODE FOR ALL CONSTRUCTION WITHIN THE
BOROUGH OF CLYMER, REPEALING ALL EXISTING BUILDING CODES AND ORDINANCES,
OPTING-IN TO THE ENFORCEMENT OF THE CODE,
APPOINTING THE COUNTY OF INDIANA TO ADMINISTER THE CODE ON BEHALF OF THE
BOROUGH OF CLYMER**

Whereas, the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania has approved Act 45 of 1999, hereafter known as the Act, establishing a Uniform Construction Code for all municipalities of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania and,

Whereas, the purpose of this code is to promote the general health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the *BOROUGH OF CLYMER* and to conform to the requirements of the Pennsylvania Construction Code Act and regulations to the Act promulgated by the Pennsylvania Department of Labor and Industry, herein after collectively referred to as the "Code"; and,

Whereas, the Act requires the enactment of an appropriate ordinance by municipalities electing to administer and enforce the building code provisions of the Code; and,

Whereas, the *BOROUGH OF CLYMER* wishes to comply with these regulations.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED, by the *BOROUGH OF CLYMER* as follows:

1. The *BOROUGH OF CLYMER* hereby elects to administer and enforce the provisions of the Pennsylvania Construction Code Act, Act 45 of 1999, 35 P.S. §§7210.101-7210.1103, as amended from time to time, and its regulations.
2. The Uniform Construction Code as established by the Pennsylvania Department of Labor and Industry, contained in 34 Pa. Code, Chapters 401-405, as amended from time to time, is hereby adopted and incorporated herein by reference as the municipal building code of the *BOROUGH OF CLYMER*.
3. Administration and enforcement of the Code within the *BOROUGH OF CLYMER* shall be undertaken by the County of Indiana through their Office of Planning and Development in accordance with a mutually agreed upon contract.
4. A Board of Appeals shall be established by resolution of the County of Indiana in conformity with the requirements of the relevant provisions of the Code, as amended from time to time, and for the purposes set forth therein. In the event of the County no longer administering and enforcing the UCC, it will be the responsibility of the *BOROUGH OF CLYMER* to establish their own board of Appeals as setforth in the Code.
5. All building code ordinances or portions of ordinances which are in effect as of the July 1, 2004 of this ordinance and whose requirements are less than the minimum requirements of the Code are hereby amended to conform with the comparable provisions of the Code.
6. All relevant ordinances, regulations and policies of the *BOROUGH OF CLYMER* not governed by the Code shall remain in full force and effect.
