

ORDINANCE NO. 315

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF CLYMER, COUNTY OF INDIANA, AND COMMONWEALTH OF PENNSYLVANIA, ESTABLISHING THE MILLAGE FOR REAL ESTATE TAX FOR THE YEAR 2006 AND INCREASING THE EMERGENCY MUNICIPAL SERVICE TAX TO FIFTY-TWO DOLLARS:

BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED by the Borough Council of the Borough of Clymer, Indiana County, Pennsylvania, and it is hereby ordained and enacted as follows:

1. The following real estate tax rates are established for the fiscal year beginning January 1, 2006, and for all tax years thereafter until changed:

- a. Real estate taxes for general purposes - 18.46 mills on each dollar of assessed valuation;
- b. Street light tax - 2.94 mills on each dollar of assessed valuation; and
- c. Fire protection services tax - 2.10 mills on each dollar of assessed valuation;

2. The Emergency Municipal Service Tax Ordinance shall be amended in Section 2(d), Section 4 and Section 5 to increase the Emergency Municipal Service Tax from Twenty Dollars (\$20.00) to Fifty-Two Dollars (\$52.00).

3. This Ordinance shall become effective January 1, 2006, and the tax rate set forth herein shall continue from year to year until changed by the Borough Council of Clymer Borough.
