

ORDINANCE NO. 37

An Ordinance vocating that portion of Gerry Street in the Borough of Clymer, from the intersection of said Gerry Street with easterly line of Penn Street Eastwardly to the terminus of said Gerry Street at or near the westerly bank of Dixon Run.

Fe it ordained and enacted by the Town Council of the Borough of Clymer, in the County of Indiana and State of Pennsylvania, and it is hereby ordained and enacted by authority of the same.

Section 1. That all that part and portion of Gerry Street, in said Porough from the intersection of said Gerry St. with Easterly line of Penn Street and extending Eastwardly a distance of one hundred and fifty feet, more or less, to the terminus of said Gerry St. at or near the westerly bank of Dixon Run, be and the same is hereby vacated.

Section 2. That all ordinances of parts of ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed. Ordained and enacted by the Town Council lawfully assembled in said Borough, this 20th day of November, A.D. 1911.
