

ORDINANCE NO. 38

An Ordinance vocating certain portions of First Street in the Borough of Clymer.

Be it ordained and enacted by the Town Council of the Borough of Clymer, County of Indiana, State of Pennsylvania, and it is hereby ordained and enacted by the authority of the same.

Section 1. That all that part and portion of First St. in said Borough of Clymer, beginning at the intersection of said First St. with Hancock St. at corner of Lot #8 North 50 degrees 15 minutes West 150 feet to the line of a sixteen foot alley, thence along line of said alley north 39 degrees 45 minutes, East 50 feet to a corner of Lot #6 on said Hancock St., thence along line of said Lot #6 South 50 degrees 15 minutes East 150 feet to the line of said Hancock Street, and thence by extension of the line of said Hancock St. across said 1st Street South 39 degrees 45 minutes West 50 feet to a corner of Lot #8, at the place of beginning be and the same is hereby vocated.

Section 2. That all that part and portion of said First St., in said Borough beginning at the intersection of said St. with a sixteen ft. alley at corner of Lot #7 on Morris St. thence along said Lot #7 on Morris St. at corner of Lot #7 thence by extension of line of said Morris St. across said First St. North 39 degrees 45 minutes East 50 feet to a point on or near the bank of Twolick Creek, at Corner of Lot #5 on said

Morris to intersection with the line of a sixteen ft. alley, at corner of said Lot #5 and thence by extension of line of said alley across said First St. South 39 degrees 45 minutes West 55 ft. to a corner of said Lot #7 at the place of beginning be and the same is hereby vocated.

Section 3. That all ordinances and parts of ordinances inconsistant herewith are repealed.
