

ORDINANCE NO. 39

Authorizing the grading, curbing, and paving of a portion of Sixth St. in the Borough of Clymer, and providing for the cost thereof.

Be it ordained and enacted by the Town Council of the Borough of Clymer. and it is hereby ordained and enacted by the authority of the same.

Section 1. That Sixth St. between the Southerly line of Lots 31 and 32 on said St. and the South side of the tracks of the Cherry Tree and Dixonville Railroad Co. be graded, curbed and paved according to the plans and specifications prepared by the Borough Engineer, and under the supervision of said Borough Engineer and the Street Committee, two-thirds of the cost and expense thereof to be collected from the owners of real estate by an equal assessment of the feet front bounding and abutting on the line of said improvement, to be estimated by said Borough Engineer.

Section 2. That the plans and specifications of said grading, curbing and paving as made and prepared by the Borough Engineer, are hereby approved and adopted.

Section 3. That the Borough Engineer upon the approval of this ordinance is hereby authorized and directed to advertise for bids for said grading, curbing and paving the president of Council and the Street Committee are hereby authorized to receive said bids, and with the approval of Council, to enter into a contract for said grading, curbing and paving.

Section 4. Any ordinance, or part of ordinance, conflicting with the provisions of this ordinance is hereby repealed.
