

ORDINANCE NO. 41

An ordinance signifying and expressing the desire of the corporate authorities of the Borough of Clymer, County of Indiana and Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, to increase the indebtedness of said Borough by the amount of twelve thousand dollars for the purposes of erecting a municipal building, building a bridge over Dixon Run on Sixth Street, paving a portion of Sixth Street and refunding certain interest-bearing obligations.

Whereas it is necessary that the bonded indebtedness of the Borough of Clymer, County of Indiana and Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, be increased for the purpose of erecting a municipal building, building a bridge over Dixon Run on Sixth Street, paving a portion of Sixth Street, and refunding certain interest-bearing obligations. Therefore, be it ordained and enacted and it is hereby ordained and enacted by and with the authority of the Town Council of the Borough of Clymer, County of Indiana and Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, approved the 20th day of April, 1874, and the amendments thereof and supplements thereto, that the corporate authorities of the said Borough of Clymer hereby signify and express their desire to increase the bonded indebtedness of said borough of Clymer by the amount of twelve thousand dollars, for the purpose of erecting a municipal building, building a bridge over Dixon Run on Sixth Street, paving a portion of Sixth Street, and refunding certain interest-bearing obligations.
