

ORDINANCE NO. 46

An ordinance annexing and admitting into the Borough of Clymer, County of Indiana and State of Pennsylvania, a certain section of land adjoining the northerly boundary line of the Borough, and plotted to conform with the Borough plan.

Whereas, a petition has been presented to the Council and Burgess of the Borough of Clymer praying for annexation and admission of a certain territory or land adjacent to the Borough, situated along the northerly boundary thereof, which has been plotted so as to conform with the general plan of the Borough; and

Whereas, said petition is signed by all the freeholders of the territory

or land so proposed to be annexed and admitted into the Borough; Now, therefore, be it ordained and enacted and it is hereby ordained and enacted by and with the authority of the same Borough Council of the Borough of Clymer, County of Indiana and State of Pennsylvania as follows:

Section 1. That there is hereby annexed and admitted into the Borough all that certain tract or land or territory, lying adjacent to the Borough along the northerly line thereof, and more particularly bounded and described as follows, to-wit:

Beginning at a corner on the east right of way line of the Cherry Tree and Dixonville Railroad, said corner being 40 feet more or less, west from the North-West corner of Lot No. 1 on Harrison Street, as shown on plan of lots of the Borough of Clymer; thence along an alley between Lot No. 1 and Lot No. 38 South 72 degrees 5 minutes East 240 feet to a corner; thence to the South by a curve having a radius of 795 feet through land formerly of John Maguire and I.M. Rhodes, of which the premises herein described are a part, a distance of 806.4 feet to a corner; thence continuing through lands formerly of I.M. Rhodes the following four corners and distances, south 70 degrees 45 minutes East 462 feet, North 85 degrees 30 minutes East 640 feet, North 82 degrees 50 minutes East 470 feet, and South 7 degrees 10 minutes East 280 feet to a corner on the North right of way line of the Cherrytree and Dixonville Railroad; thence along the North and East right of way line of the Cherrytree and Dixonville Railroad, South 75 degrees 55 minutes West 736 feet to a corner; thence North 14 degrees 5 minutes West 10 feet to a corner; thence to the North by a curve having a radius of 1035 feet a distance of 2203.3 feet to a corner at the place of beginning, containing 18.39 acres, more or less;

Which said tract of land or territory shall forever hereafter be admitted taken and allowed to be a part of the Borough of Clymer, subject to the jurisdiction and government of the municipal authorities thereof, as fully as if the same had been originally a part of said Borough, and shall be known as the "Dixon Run Addition".

Section 2. That a certified copy of this ordinance, together with the description and a plot showing the courses and distances of the Boundaries of the Borough before and after the annexation and admission of said tract of land or territory hereby annexed and admitted, shall be filed in the Court of Quarter Sessions of the County of Indiana, and notice thereof filed in the office of the County Commissioners of said County.

Section 3. That the expense of publishing and posting this ordinance shall be paid by the petitions for the annexation and admission of said tract of land or territory to the Borough.

Section 4. That all ordinances or parts of ordinances conflicting with the provisions of this ordinance be and the same are hereby repealed.

Ordained and enacted by the Town Council, lawfully assembled, this 8th day of January, 1917.
