Notice of an election, to increase the Bonded Indebtedness of the Clymer Borough.

Borough of Clymer, County of Indiana, State of Pennsylvania

Notice of an Election

Notice is hereby given to the electors of Clymer Borough, County of Indiana, and State of Pennsylvania,

In pursuance and by authority of an ordinance No. 48, duly enacted and approved the 18th day of April, 1919, that a special election be held on the 24th day of May 1919, between the hours of 7:00 P.M. and 7:00 P.M. at the place of holding the General Election in said Borough, for the purpose of obtaining the assent of the qualified electors of said Borough, to an increase of the bonded indebtedness of said Borough, the Corporate authorities of said Borough by Ordinance No. 47 approved the 4th day of April, 1919, signified and expressed their desire for such increase of indebtedness.

The amount of the last assessed valuation of the taxable property in said Borough is \$377,845.00.

The total amount of the present actual debt of said Borough is 11,800.00

The amount of the proposed increase in the indebtedness of said Borough is 14,500.00

The percentage of the proposed increase in the indebtedness of said Borough computed upon the last assessed valuation, is three and eight tenths plus (3.8 plus %) per centum. The proposed increase of said Borough of Clymer is for the purpose of paving the streets of said Borough of Clymer and of paying said Borough's share of the cost of paving the Streets.
