

ORDINANCE NO. 49

An Ordinance providing for the paving, curbing and drainage of that part of Franklin Street in the Borough of Clymer, County of Indiana, and Commonwealth of Pennsylvania beginning at the North line of third Street and extending to the North line of Fourth Street beginning at the South line of Seventh Street and extending to the concrete bridge over Twolick Creek to a width of twelve feet in addition to the permanent improvement of that part of said street taken over by said State Highway Department, and providing for the collection of the whole cost of the real estate abutting on said improvement by an equal assessment on the foot front.

Whereas, the State Highway Department has heretofore taken over and is about to permanently improve that part of Franklin Street beginning at the north line of Third Street and extending to the north line of Fourth Street; also that part of said Franklin Street beginning at the south line of seventh Street and extending to the concrete bridge across Twolick Creek of a width of eighteen feet;

Now be it ordained and enacted and it is hereby ordained and enacted by and with the authority of the Town Council of the Borough of Clymer, County of Indiana and Commonwealth of Pennsylvania:

Section 1. That Franklin Street in said Borough of Clymer be permanently improved to the width of thirty feet on that part of said Street beginning at the north line of Third Street and extending to the north line of Fourth Street, and on that part of said Street beginning at the south line of Seventh Street and extending to the north end of the concrete bridge over Twolick Creek, being twelve feet in addition to the permanent improvement of said Street about to be made by the State Highway Department.

Section 2. That said permanent improvement shall be made by paving said additional width with vitrified brick with a concrete base, and shall be provided with cement curbing.

Section 3. That the contract for the paving, curbing and drainage of said additional width hereinbefore provided for shall be made by the State Highway Department upon the same specifications which the State Highway Department shall adopt for the eighteen feet by it taken over and to be improved.

Section 4. That the whole cost of the paving, curbing and drainage of said additional width of twelve feet on said Franklin Street shall be collected by the Borough of Clymer from the owners of the real estate abutting on said improvement by an equal assessment on the foot front; said assessment to be made by the Borough Engineer.

Section 5. That the State Highway Department shall be paid the costs and expenses of said improvement in the first instance by the Borough of Clymer upon proper estimates and bills submitted by the State Highway Department's Engineers.

Ordained and enacted by the Town Council lawfully assembled in said Borough of Clymer the 21st day of November, 1919.
