

ORDINANCE NO. 51

65

An Ordinance prohibiting and regulating the running at large of horses, cattle, swine and other animals, including geese and ducks and fixing penalties for violation of this ordinance. Be it ordained and enacted by the Town Council of the Borough of Clymer, in the county of Indiana and State of Pennsylvania, and it is hereby ordained and enacted by the authority of the same.

Section 1. No horses, cattle, sheep, swine and other animals, including geese, and ducks, shall be permitted at large or on the streets, alleys, roads, or pavements within the corporate limits of the Borough of Clymer at any time.

Section 2. Any person, the owner of any of said animals, violating the provisions of Section 1, shall pay a fine or penalty of not less than \$2.00, or more than \$10.00.

Ordained and enacted by the Town Council, lawfully assembled in said Borough, April 4th, 1921.
