Resolution of the Council

Resolution of the Council of the Borough of Clymer, approving the lines, grades, drainage structures and all other structures appearing on plans showing proposed reconstruction work in said Borough.

Whereas, the State Highway Department has submitted to the Borough Council of Clymer, plans showing proposed construction work on State Highway Route No. 54, from East Borough Line, Station 1552 plus 49.38 to West Borough Line, Station 1651 plus 90.6 a distance of 9941.87 feet, as shown by the plans of said Highway Department, approved April, 8th, 1921, therefore, be it resolved and ordained on motion of J.W. Rankin, seconded by J.W. Haddick and carried, that the Burgess and Council of the said Borough of Clymer, ordained the said plans of the State Highway Department, together with the lines, grades, drainage structures, and all other structures thereon shown, with full force and effect, as the action of said Borough, and

Be it further ordained, that all ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent herewith, be and the same are hereby repealed.
