

An ordinance vacating a certain portion of Wilson Street in the Borough of Clymer, beginning at a westerly line of Penn Street and extending westwardly to the Easterly line of a sixteen foot alley adjoining a sixteen foot alley adjoining the Borough line and supplying said Wilson Street from the Westerly line of said Penn Street Westerly to the Easterly line of said sixteen foot alley adjoining the Borough line.

Whereas, the Dixon Run Land Co. being the sole owner of all the abutting properties, has petitioned Town Council to vacate and supply certain portions of Wilson Street, hereinafter fully described, expressly warranting all claims for damages by reason thereof. Therefore, be it ordained and enacted by the Town Council of the Borough of Clymer, in the County of Indiana, and State of Pennsylvania, and it is hereby ordained and enacted by the authority of the same.

Section 1. That all that part and portion of Wilson Street in said Borough as laid out on lot #41 Penn Street bounded and described as follows: beginning at the southwest corner of said lot #41 Penn Street, where same corners on Dixon Road, thence by the easterly line of said Dixon Road North nine degrees fifteen minutes West fifty feet to the corner of lot #42 North eighty degrees forty-five minutes East one hundred fifty feet to corner at line of Penn Street; thence by the westerly line of said Penn Street south nine degrees fifteen minutes East fifty feet to a corner of lot #40 Penn Street and thence along said lot #40 south eighty degrees forty-five minutes west one hundred fifty feet to corner in line of said Dixon Road at place of beginning, be and the same is hereby vacated.

Section 2. That all that part and portion of Wilson Street in said Borough as laid out on lot #91 Dixon Road bounded and described as follows: beginning at the westerly line of Dixon Road at the corner of lot #91 Dixon Road thence by lot #91 south eighty degrees forty-five minutes west one hundred fifty feet to a sixteen foot alley at the rear of lots on the west side of Dixon Road thence by said alley north nine degrees fifteen minutes west fifty feet to a corner of lots #92 Dixon Road; thence by said lot #92 north eighty degrees forty-five minutes East one hundred fifty feet to Dixon Road; thence by said Dixon Road south nine degrees fifteen minutes east fifty feet to corner to the place of beginning, be and the same is hereby vacated.

Section 3. That in lieu and place of that portion of said Wilson Street hereinbefore vacated by section one of this ordinance there is hereby laid out and adopted as a part and portion of said Wilson Street, a street beginning at a point on Penn Street at the north east corner of lot #40 Penn Street thence through lots #40 and 38 Penn Street south forty-seven degrees four minutes west one hundred eighty and three-tenths feet to a point on the easterly line of Dixon Road north nine degrees fifteen minutes west fifty feet to a point at corner of lot #40 Penn Street, thence through lots #40 and 41 Penn Street north forty-seven degrees four minutes east one hundred eighty and three-tenths feet to the southeast corner of lot #42 Penn Street; thence by the westerly line of Penn Street south nine degrees fifteen minutes east fifty feet to corner of lot #40 Penn Street at place of beginning.

Section 4. That in lieu and in place of that part and portion of said Wilson Street, hereinbefore vacated by Section 2 of this ordinance there is hereby laid out and adopted as a part and portion of said Wilson St. a street beginning on the westerly line at the Dixon Road at the corner of lot #88 Dixon Road thence by said lot #88 south eighty degrees forty-five minutes west one hundred fifty feet to a sixteen foot alley at the rear of lots laid out on the west side of Dixon Road, thence by said alley north nine degrees fifteen minutes west fifty feet to the corner of lots #90 Dixon Road thence by said lot #90 north eighty degrees forty-five minutes east one hundred fifty feet to a point on the westerly line

of Dixon Road, thence by the westerly line of said Dixon Road south nine degrees fifteen minutes east fifty feet to the place of beginning being lot #89 Dixon Road as laid out on the plot or plan of Clymer Borough.

Section 5. That within ten days after approval of this ordinance notice shall be given by handbills posted along the line of the proposed improvement stating the fact and date of passage of this ordinance, that the petition therefore was signed by a majority in interest and number of owners abutting. And that any person interested and denying the fact that the petition was so signed may appeal to the Court of Common Pleas of Indiana County within thirty days after the passage hereof.

Section 6. That the map and general plan of the Borough be and hereby is changed, modified and amended in accordance with sections 3 and 4 of this ordinance.

Section 7. That all ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.
