

Resolution of Council of the Borough of Clymer, repealing ordinance enacted March 1st, 1926 and approved the same day whereby the lines and grades, drainage structures and all other structures appearing on plans showing proposed Re-constructive work in said Borough were approved.

Whereas, there was enacted and approved by Council and Burgess of the Borough of Clymer on the first day of March A.D. 1926, an Ordinance approving plans of the Department of Highways of Pennsylvania, showing proposed constructive work on Route #262 from Station One plus 00 to Station 6 plus 52, a distance of 652 feet.

Now therefore be it resolved and ordained on motion of John Steels seconded by D.W. Lyle, and carried, that the Council and Burgess of the said Borough of Clymer, do hereby ordain that said Resolution or ordinance be and the same is hereby repealed.
