

ORDINANCE NO. 66

To the Commissioners of Indiana County:

Whereas, the section of highway in Clymer Borough, Indiana County, Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, being about 3600 in length and situated as follows: Beginning at a point on Route 13 at the intersection of the center line of Franklin and Sixth Streets, as shown on the official Borough map, and running thence in a westerly direction along Sixth Street in said Borough to the intersection of Sixth Street with Penn Street; thence in a northerly direction along Penn Street to the intersection of Penn Street with a road leading to Dixonville, known as Route 43.

Whereas, state aid is desired for the permanent improvement of the section of highway in Clymer Borough under the act approved May 31, 1911, providing for the establishment of a State Highway Department, etc, and supplement approved June 5th 1913, therefore be it resolved that the Borough Council of said Clymer Borough in regular session assembled on this sixth

day of June, 1927, do on behalf of said Borough hereby petition for state aid as hereinbefore stated and be it further,
Resolved, that the said Borough Council do agree for themselves and their successors in office to provide for the payment of and to pay to the Commonwealth from the Borough funds, in the manner provided by the said Act and the supplement thereto. One fourth of the total expense of said improvement where due and be it further,

Resolved that the commissioners of said county of Indiana, be and hereby petitioned to join in requesting the State Highway Department to extend state aid for the said road improvement under the said Act approved June, 6, 1927.
