

ORDINANCE NO. 67

Resolution of Council of the Borough of Clymer approving the lines, grades, drainage structures and all other structures appearing on plans showing proposed re-construction work in said Borough.

Whereas, the Department of Highways has submitted to the Borough Council of Clymer Borough, plans showing proposed construction work on Department of Highways, Route #262, from Second Street to Borough line along Franklin Street, a distance of 400 feet, as shown by the plans of said Department of Highways approved July 11, 1927, therefore,

Be it resolved and ordained on motion by John Steele, seconded by Frank Tate and carried, that the Burgess and Council of the said Borough of Clymer, ordain the said plans of the Department of Highways together with the lines, grades, drainage structures and all other structures, thereon shown, with full force and effect as the action of said Borough, and,

Be it further ordained that all ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent herewith be and the same are repealed, Passed and enacted at a session of Council of the Borough of Clymer, held this 23rd day of July A.D., 1927.
