

ORDINANCE NO. 69

Resolution of Council of the Borough of Clymer, requesting the Commissioners of Indiana County to petition for the improvement of State Highway Route #508 in said Borough beginning at the intersection of Sixth and Franklin Streets thence northward along Penn Street to the Borough line and agreeing to contribute to the cost thereof.

To the Commissioners of Indiana County:

Whereas, the section of State Highway, Route #508 in the Borough of Clymer, County of Indiana, being about 3700 feet in length and situated as follows: beginning at the intersection of Sixth and Franklin Streets thence westward along Sixth Street, a distance of about 1400 feet to Penn Street, a distance of about 2300 feet to the Borough line, is in need of reconstruction, therefore be it

Resolved, that the Commissioners of said County of Indiana be and are hereby requested to petition the Department of Highways to extend State aid for said road improvement under the Acts of May 31, 1911, and June 5, 1913, Special Aid Plan and be it further

Resolved, that the Council of the Borough of Clymer do agree for themselves and their successors in office to provide for the payment of, and to pay to the Commissioners of Indiana County, one-fourth of the total expense of eighteen feet of said improvement when due.

Adopted and enacted by the Council of the Borough of Clymer, lawfully assembled this 23rd day of January, 1928.
