

ORDINANCE NO. 77

An Ordinance providing for the improvement of Sixth Street and agreeing to contract and pay therefor.

Whereas: the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, by the Secretary of Highways, is about to reconstruct and improve to a width of thirty-two feet (32), a section of State Highway Route 508, Indiana County, lying within the Borough of Clymer on Sixth Street, and

Whereas: the Borough of Clymer desires to place certain inlet castings and construct integral concrete pavement under integral curbing, in connection with the reconstruction of said section of State Highway, description of which is as follows:

From the intersection with Route 54 at Franklin and Sixth Streets, station 0 plus 30, to approximately 285 feet north of Dixon Run, at Station 15 plus 00.

Now, therefore, be it ordained and that the said Borough of Clymer, by its duly authorized officers, enter into a contract with the successful bidder providing for the aforesaid additional improvements not covered by the improvements to be made by the Commonwealth at an estimated cost of Two Thousand Five Hundred Two Dollars and no cents (\$2502.00) and that the said officials be authorized to enter into an agreement with the Secretary of Highways, providing for such improvement in the manner aforesaid and the payment thereof.
