

ORDINANCE NO. 79

An Ordinance providing for the paving of an additional width on each side of the proposed paving of Sixth Street, between Franklin Street and Sherman Street, the additional width to be three (3) feet and five (5) inches on either side, making a total width of pavement of forty (40) feet overall. The Borough of Clymer agreeing to contract with the Contractor, M. Bennett and Sons, for the paving of said additional width at the unit prices provided for in the general contract.

Whereas, the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, by the Secretary of Highways, has contracted for the improvement of Sixth Street to a width of thirty-two feet (32) and two (2) inches, a section of State Highway, Route No. 503 lying within the Borough of Clymer on Sixth Street; and

Whereas, the Borough of Clymer passed an ordinance dated June 8, 1934, providing for said improvement, and also entered into an agreement with the Contractor, M. Bennett and Sons, to pay for the Borough's share of said improvement; and

Whereas, all of the property owners on Sixth Street between Franklin Street and Sherman Street have entered into an agreement whereby they agree to pay their respective shares to the Borough of Clymer of the full cost of the additional width of three (3) feet and five (5) inches on each side, making a total width of pavement of forty (40) feet overall.

Now, therefore, be it ordained that the said Borough of Clymer, by its duly authorized officers, enter into a contract with the Contractor, M.

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Bennett and Sons, providing for the aforesaid additional extra width of improvement and payment of the full cost thereof not covered by the ordinance dated June 8, 1934, at an estimated cost of Eight Hundred Seventy Six Dollars and eighty cents (\$876.80)

RESOLUTION FOR ADDITIONAL LIGHTS

Whereas, it is provided by paragraph Fourth of a street lighting contract dated August 1st, 1934 between the Borough of Clymer as party of the first part and Pennsylvania Electric Company, as party of the second part, that said Company shall furnish such additional lamps of the type described in the contract, as the Borough may from time to time direct; provided that no new lamps shall be added during the last three (3) months of the term of said contract, except by mutual consent; and

Whereas, the Borough desires to install additional street lights under the provisions of paragraph fourth of the said contract dated August 1, 1934.

Now, therefore, be it resolved, that the Borough of Clymer pursuant to the provisions of said contract of August 1, 1934, does hereby order and direct Pennsylvania Electric Company to furnish two (2) additional lamps of 100 and 250 candle power, said lamps to be placed at the location shown on a certain plan No. "Sketch Attached" dated March 4, 1935 and entitled "Location of Lamps" hereto attached and made a part hereof and hereby agrees to pay the said Pennsylvania Electric Company for such additional lighting at the rates provided for in the said contract of August 1, 1934.
