

ORDINANCE NO. 81

An Ordinance providing for the furnishing of electric street lighting service to the Borough of Clymer, County of Indiana, and State of Pennsylvania.

Whereas: Pennsylvania Electric Company has filed with the Borough Secretary a form of contract containing specifications for electric traffic Control service which is satisfactory to the Borough:

Be it ordained and enacted by the Council of the Borough of Clymer and it is hereby ordained and enacted by the authority of the same.

Section 1. That the Borough of Clymer enter into and execute a contract with the said Pennsylvania Electric Company in substantially the form now on file, with the Borough Secretary, for the furnishing of electric traffic control service to the said Borough.

Section 2. That the Burgess and the Borough Secretary be and they hereby

are authorized to execute the said contract on behalf of the Borough.

Section 3. That all ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.

A Resolution approving the plans of the Department of Highways of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, showing proposed improvement on Franklin Street and Franklin Street Extension in the Borough of Clymer, Pennsylvania.

Whereas, the Department of Highways has submitted to the Borough Council of Clymer, plans showing proposed construction work on State Highway, Route No. 54, Sec. R-1 on Franklin Street, from Station (434 plus 89) to Franklin St. Extension (464 plus 22) Station (461 plus 22) (461 plus 58.13) a distance of 4,369.13 feet, as shown by the plans of said Department of Highways, approved by the District Engineer 1936.

Section 1. Be it resolved by the Town Council of the Borough of Clymer, Pennsylvania, that the plans prepared and submitted by the Department of Highways as aforesaid, be, and the same are hereby approved for Franklin Street and Franklin Street Extension as shown on said plans, and the Dept. of Highways is hereby authorized to proceed with the improvement contemplated thereby. The Borough will proceed to enact an ordinance or ordinances, if any be necessary, to properly provide for the contemplated improvement, and a right-of-way width of 60 feet between property lines.

Section 2. This resolution shall be effective immediately upon its approval.
