

ORDINANCE NO. 82

And Ordinance approving and establishing the lines, grades, drainage structures, and all other structures appearing on the plans of the Department of Highways of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, showing proposed improvement of Franklin Street and Franklin Street Extension in the Borough of Clymer, Pennsylvania.

Whereas, the Department of Highways has submitted to the Borough Council of Clymer, plans showing proposed construction work on State Highway Route No. 54 Section R-1 on Franklin Street and Franklin Street Extension, from Station

(434 plus 89) (461 plus 22)
(464 plus 22) to Station (481 plus 58.13)

a distance of 4,369.13 feet, as shown by the plans of said Department of Highways, approved 1935.

Section 1. Be it enacted and ordained by the Town Council of the Borough of Clymer, and it is hereby enacted and ordained by authority of the same that the lines, grades, courses, distances, drainage structures, and all other structures shown on the plans prepared and submitted by the Department of Highways as aforesaid, be, and the same are adopted, and are hereby enacted and ordained as and for the true and proper lines, grades, courses, distances, drainage structures, and other structures of and for Franklin Street and Franklin Street Extension as shown on the said plans, and a right of way width of 60 feet between property lines.

Section 2. All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent herewith be and the same are hereby repealed.

Section 3. This ordinance shall be effective immediately upon its approval as provided by law.
