

ORDINANCE NO. 85

An ordinance, signifying and expressing the desire of the corporate authorities of the borough of Clymer, County of Indiana, Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, to increase the bonded indebtedness of the said borough by the amount of eight thousand dollars (\$8,000.00), for the purpose of providing money to pay off and to fund floating indebtedness of said borough to said amount.

Whereas, it is necessary that the bonded indebtedness of the Borough of Clymer, County of Indiana, Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, be increased for the purpose of providing money to pay off and to fund floating indebtedness of the said Borough of Clymer to the amount of eight thousand dollars (\$8,000.00).

Now, therefore, be it ordained and enacted by the Town Council of the Borough of Clymer, lawfully assembled in said Borough, and it is hereby ordained and enacted by the authority of the same, in accordance with the Art of Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, Approved the 20th day of April, 1874, and the Amendments thereof, and Supplements thereto, that the corporate authorities of the said Borough of Clymer have desired, and hereby unanimously signify and express their desire, to increase the bonded indebtedness of said Borough of Clymer by the amount of eight thousand dollars (\$8,000.00), for the purpose of providing money to pay off and to fund floating indebtedness of the said Borough to the said amount.
