ORDINANCE OF BOROUGH COUNCIL

Ordinance of Borough Council

An Ordinance providing for the improvement of Franklin Street, and agreement to contract and pay therefore.

Whereas, the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania by the Secretary of Highways is about to improve a section 38 in width of State Highway Route 54 section R-5, Traffic Route 80, Indiana County lying within the borough of Clymer on Franklin Street: and

Whereas, the borough of Clymer desires to pay for the construction of all curbs and all grading, paving and drainage structures back of face of curb lines at intersecting streets and alleys, as indicated on the drawings in connection with the improvement of the following described section of State Highway:

Route 54, section R-5: From a point 51 feet Northeast of the intersection of Second Street and Franklin Street at station 1573+22 thence along Franklin Street (Route 54) to approximately 0.26 miles south east of the intersection of Routes 54 and 508 at Sixth Street at station 1606+48.

Now therefore, be it ordained, that the said Borough of Clymer, by its duly authorized officers enter into a contract with the successful bidder, providing for the aforesaid additional improvement to be made by the Commonwealth, at an estimated cost of nineteen thousand two hundred (\$19,200.00) dollars and that the said officers be authorized to enter into an agreement with the Secretary of Highways, providing for such improvement in the manner aforesaid.
