

ORDINANCE NO. 25

Providing for the adoption of an official borough map. Be it enacted and ordained by the Borough of Clymer, in Council assembled, and it is hereby enacted and ordained by authority of the same:

Section 1. That the official map of the Borough of Clymer, Indiana County, Pennsylvania, shall be the map of H. J. Hinterleitner Engineer, dated May, 1908, as revised by Paul Gill, Engineer, on January 20, 1948.

Section 2. That the proper officials be and they are hereby authorized to record a copy of the aforesaid map in the Recorder's Office in Indiana County.

RESOLUTION

AUTHORIZING A TEMPORARY LOAN

BE IT RESOLVED by the Town Council of the Borough of Clymer, that a temporary loan of Ten Thousand (\$10,000.00) Dollars be made at interest not exceeding three per centum (3%) from such source or sources as shall be designated by the President and Secretary of Council, on the credit of the Borough, in anticipation of taxes to be collected and to be paid out of the first monies available from taxes, and that a certificate or certificates of indebtedness be issued therefor, signed by the President of Council and attested by the Secretary, a record of the essentials of which loan shall be read into the minutes at the next regular meeting of Council.
